### Eagle Day is June 16th - Volunteers Needed


Eagle Day is a **FUN** open format day for Skyview students **FULL** of a variety of **FREE** activities provided by PTSA and ASB.

### End-of-Year Student Device Procedure

#### Returning students will keep their devices this summer!

Students will be keeping their assigned computing devices over the summer months to allow for continuous learning. Students and families are expected to take care of their assigned device by keeping it charged and in its bag when not in use. Students who are enrolled in summer learning programs are expected to bring their device to summer programs each day. If families need support using their device or troubleshooting technical issues, they should call 425-408-7631 or create a help ticket at <u>http://go.nsd.org/studenttechhelp</u>.

#### Students <u>withdrawing</u> from NSD must turn in devices to Skyview library by June 16th.

*Families who are withdrawing from Northshore are expected to return any technology devices assigned to their student, including computers, tablets, hotspots and all accessories such as bags and chargers. Our school will be collecting devices in the Skyview Library on June 15th, 16th and 17th. Withdrawing students who do not return their devices and accessories will be issued a fine for replacement.* 

# Families who wish not to keep a device over the summer need to complete <u>this opt out form</u> by June 15th.

Families may not need or want to take their student's device home over the summer. Families who wish to opt out of keeping their student's assigned device will need to indicate that they are "opting out" by completing the <u>Opt Out Form</u>. This form will help our staff to plan efficiently for sending devices home for summer learning. Students opting out of a summer device will need to return their device, bag, charger to the Skyview Library on June 15th, 16th, or 17th. When students return to school in the Fall, any student who does not have an assigned device will be assigned one for school year learning.

### Taking Care of the Chromebook

Students are responsible for the general care of the Chromebook they have been issued by the school district. Students with Chromebooks that are broken or fail to work properly must contact the School Technology Specialist as soon as possible so that they can be taken care of properly. District-owned Chromebooks should never be taken to an outside computer service for any type of repairs or maintenance. Students should never leave their Chromebooks unattended.

### <u>Screen Care</u> <u>Asset Tags</u>

**General Precautions** 

- No food or drink should be next to Chromebooks.
- Cords, cables, and removable storage devices (e.g. thumb drives) must be inserted carefully into appropriate ports on the Chromebooks.
- Chromebooks should not be used or stored near pets.
- Chromebooks should not be used with the power cord plugged in when the cord may be a tripping hazard.
- Chromebooks must remain free of any writing, drawing, stickers, and labels.
- Heavy objects should never be placed on top of Chromebooks.
- Chromebooks should never be loaned to another student or individual during the school day or otherwise.

Carrying the Chromebook

- Always transport Chromebooks with care. Failure to do so may result in disciplinary action or a fine for damages.
- Students should hold the Chromebooks (cover closed) with two hands if they need to carry the Chromebook anywhere inside or outside of the classroom during instructional time.
- Never lift a Chromebook by the screen.
- Never carry a Chromebook with the screen open.

### A Message from the Nurse

### END OF THE YEAR MEDICATION PICKUP

If your student has emergent, life-saving medication in the health room (epi-pens, seizure medication, or glucagon), the medication cannot be picked up prior to their last day of school. Medication pickup will be **Friday, June 17th from 9:45am- 11:00am.** Non-emergent medication can be picked up anytime between now and the end of the school year by an authorized adult. All medication must be picked up prior to June 17th at 11:00am, or it will be destroyed.

In addition to medications, I will be providing you with the proper paperwork you will need to have medications at school for the 22/23 school year.

#### Life Threatening Medications:

Students who have Life Threatening Conditions will need to make plans over the summer to have Emergency Medications with physician's orders at school and ready *before the first day of school.* Letters will be sent home in June for those students who currently have Emergency Care Plans in place and will include all necessary forms to be completed for next fall. Please contact the school nurse if you need assistance with forms or have questions.

#### Immunizations for 2022- 2023

Please make sure student immunizations are up to date and on file in the Health Room. Middle School Vaccines include:

- Two doses of Varicella (chicken pox) vaccine will be required for K-12th grade students.
- The other vaccine that is sometimes overlooked is the Tdap vaccine which is required at 11-12 years of age, or by 7th grade entry.

The school nurse will be working in the health room starting August 23rd (Non-student days) and will be available to drop off medications/physician orders or review emergency care plans for students with life threatening conditions or address any other parent concerns. Parents are welcome to call ahead to check scheduling drop offs, 425-408-6806. Medication/physician orders can also be faxed ahead to 425-408-6902, attention the school nurse.

#### **COVID UPDATE**

As you know, COVID cases are on the rise in Western Washington, including here at Skyview. Because of this rise, there is a possibility your student may have been exposed to COVID either at school, or outside of school. The most important thing you can do is to keep your student home if they have any symptoms of COVID, such as nasal congestion, headache, sore throat, nausea, or a fever. If your student tests positive, please alert the nurse as soon as possible at jcelms@nsd.org. Please do not allow your student to come to school if they have any symptoms of illness. Thank you for doing your part to keep our Skyview students, families, and staff safe.

While masks remain optional, we highly recommend your student wears a mask while at school. **If your student is choosing to wear a mask, please send an ample supply to school with them so that they have them on hand**. We have a limited supply in the building.



# High School Athletics Registration

#### 2022-23 NORTH CREEK HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETICS REGISTRATION

If you will be a freshman at NCHS next year and are interested in participating in sports, Athletics registration for all sports is OPEN for the 2022-23 school year. FinalForms is an online registration platform for Athletics registration. You must be



registered to receive information and updates from coaches, including information on possible summer conditioning sessions.

#### **Required Prior to Participation in Athletics**

To be cleared to participate in the first day of weight training/conditioning, tryouts, or practice, a FinalForms registration must be completed by both parent and student and a current <u>sports</u> <u>physical</u> must be on file with the NCHS Athletic Office. Sports physicals are good for two years from the exam date and can be uploaded in FinalForms during the registration process. Visit our <u>Register for Athletics</u> page for more information and to register on FinalForms. Because the default year is 21-22 until June 13, you will need to click on the Switch to 22/23 Registration **BLUE** button to register.

#### Academic Eligibility Requirements

Student athletes in high school are expected to meet or exceed a 2.0 GPA to be eligible to participate in school-sponsored activities. There are regular grade checks for each sports season.

- NSD Standard: Minimum 2.0 GPA each semester
- WIAA Standard: Passing 6 classes
