Students Receiving SPED Services: The IEP team will determine appropriate placement for core courses in qualifying areas. Students should register only for core courses in Section One that are not in their qualifying area. If there are any questions, contact your student's case manager or counselor. (Note: SPED is an acronym for Special Education.)

Students Receiving AAP/Highly Capable Services: These students will be automatically placed into AAP classes based on current year placements or information from the district. Math placement will also be determined by the district. Students should register only for core courses in Section One that are not in their qualifying area. (Note: AAP is an acronym for Advance Academic Placement.)

Students Receiving EL Services: These students should register for their core classes. Students who qualify for an EL Language Arts class will be placed in that course with parent notification, this course will take the place of an elective. Complete all sections of this form. (Note: EL is an acronym for English Learners)
