Students Receiving SPED Services: The IEP team will determine appropriate placement for core courses in qualifying areas. This includes students in our FSA, Mid-Level, and LC programs. Students should register only for core courses in Section One that are in their qualifying area. If there are any questions, contact your student's case manager or counselor. (Note: SPED is an acronym for Special Education.)

Students Receiving AAP/Highly Capable Services: These students will be automatically placed into AAP classes based on current year placements or information from the district. Math placement will also be determined by the district. Students should register only for core courses in Section One that are not in their qualifying area. (Note: AAP is an acronym for Advance Academic Placement.)

Multilingual Students Receiving ELD Services: These students should register for their core classes. Students who qualify for an ELD Language Arts class will be placed in that course with parent notification. This course will replace the student's grade-level English course. Complete all sections of this form. (Note: ELD is an acronym for English Language Development)
